New Washrooms

The present washroom facility was constructed in the early 1950's. It isn't esthetically pleasing or environmentally sound. It's time to install a new state-of-the-art septic system that meets environmental standards and has sufficient capacity for our growing camp population. Above ground will be a new washroom facility with flush toilets, proper sinks and shower stalls. The water delivery system will have upgrades to service the new facilities. This work also means the camp can be used in other seasons by church and community groups looking for a special retreat setting for their meetings and gatherings.

Dining Hall Improvements

The Dining Hall is located on a hillside. Over time the strain of gravity has caused the floor to crack, walls to shift and support posts to twist. Stabilization of the hillside will be done. The floor and walls will be repaired. And while we are at this work, we will also carry out some much needed renovations to expand the seating capacity and kitchen facilities.



Our Plan

Our plan and goal is to manage the entire project using principles of good stewardship and environmental care. Trees will be protected and attention to erosion possibilities will be attended to with careful landscaping.
