HISTORICAL HIGHLIGHTS

- 1969 Toronto United Church Council purchased 15 acres of land in Northeast Newmarket, at the request of York Presbytery, in order to provide affordable housing.
- 1975 United Church Developments (York Presbytery) was incorporated.
First community information meeting.
- 1979, 1983-84, 1985 Ontario Municipal Board Hearings regarding rezoning the land.
- 1987 The Board decided to attempt to relocate the project, and to request The Starr Group to search for other appropriate sites.
- 1989 The 15 acres were sold to a developer.
- 1989 A new application was presented to the Ministry of Housing for 90 units of non-profit housing on a site near Yonge and Mulock in Newmarket. This site was made available to us by Ronto Developments on a turnkey basis.
- 1991 July, the first units were available for occupancy.
